International NAFIPS participants  
who are going to Carlsbad Caverns  
on Friday November 4.**

Any Non-Immigrant visa holder, tourist, student, visitor, employee, etcetera, with a valid passport and visa, can retrieve an electronic I-94. It is strongly recommended that all international visitors carry their passport, visa, and I-94 (electronic or the regular one) at all times.

Please find below the USCIS web link to retrieve an electronic I-94. As soon as the applicant finishes completing the “Enter Traveler Info” screen, click on “Most Recent I-94 Results” and click on Print, to get the electronic I-94, (please see snapshots below).
